This supply list should cover all of your classes. However, some teachers will have additional supply requests - typically shared with you at Open House or the first days of class.

Quantity	Item	Example
1	<p>Good quality <u>3-ring binder (1-2") or notebook</u></p> <p><i>Previous students have really liked the "Five Star Flex 1-inch Hybrid NoteBinder" (pic on right)</i></p>	
2 sets of 8	<p><u>Colored tab subject dividers</u> to either use for your portfolio and/or your regular 3 ring binder.</p>	
1	<p>Zipper pouch to store supplies (3-hole punched heavy-duty Ziplock bags work)</p> <p><i>You can choose the style. Heavy-duty is best</i></p>	
4 or more packages	<p>Loose-leaf filler paper (If you spend extra and get the reinforced holes, you'll be glad.)</p>	
1 pack of 4 dry erase markers	<p>Dry Erase Markers (<i>thick style</i>)</p>	
2 or more	<p>Pens (a variety of colors is helpful)</p>	
12	<p>Pencils</p>	
1 pack (at least 3+)	<p>Colored highlighters</p>	

1	<p>Scientific calculator (with trig functions- sin, cos, tan): <i>(talk to your math teacher)</i></p>	
25+	<p>Sheet Protectors</p>	
1	<p>Assignment calendar or agenda There should be enough lines under each day to write down work from each class. <u>9th Graders will be given a planner.</u> Grades 10-12 will have the option to receive one at school if they want (possibly a small fee \$2-\$3)</p>
